Shared resources for groups

This year we launched our IA Groups Shared Resources portal, allowing volunteers to access templates, guides and policies that support their roles. Volunteer recruitment

You may have noticed a couple of tweaks that we have introduced recently to encourage more people to consider volunteering with us. Firstly, we've added a 'volunteer' button on the homepage of our website. This will take people directly through to the enquiry page so that they receive a quick response when expressing an interest in volunteering.

For new members and those who are renewing, we've included a question about whether they would like to volunteer.

This means that we can have an initial chat with members looking to get involved and easily signpost them to volunteering opportunities in their area.

We know recruiting new volunteers can be a challenge for our group network. Hopefully, these changes will lead to more people considering volunteering with us and that we can find the right role for them.

Volunteering in action: opportunities to support awareness events in December
